This document provides an overview of the resolved issues in ProgressBook Suite v9.1.8.

Resolved Issues

The following issues have been addressed in ProgressBook in this release.

	Parent Access
1889	<p>Manage Alerts section of the My Account tab on the Parent Access Web Site does not display if a student linked to the account has only one character in the middle name.</p> <p>The Manage Alerts section of the My Account tab on the Parent Access Web Site displays if a student linked to the account has only one character in the middle name.</p>
	Student Averages and Grades
1920	<p>Student's averages do not update for students in a class in which the staff_DBID for the teacher assigned to that class is more 32,000.</p> <p>ProgressBook has been updated so that student's averages calculate for students in a class in which the staff_DBID for the teacher assigned to that class is greater than 32,000.</p>
1912	<p>Error occurs when calculating student grades for assignments using the Extra Credit assignment type with 0 possible points.</p> <p>The error that prevented calculating students' grades for assignments using the Extra Credit assignment type with 0 possible points has been corrected.</p> <p><i>Note: If you are using weighted averages by assignment type, you should not use an assignment type exclusively for extra credit. In weighted average by assignment type calculations, ProgressBook calculates a separate average for each assignment type and cannot calculate an average based on 0 points possible for extra credit. When using weighted averages by assignment type, we recommend including extra credit assignments in another assignment type which will prevent having an assignment type with 0 points possible.</i></p>
1856	<p>In classes using Custom Setup 2, student's averages are not updated when assignments are deleted.</p> <p>ProgressBook has been updated so that student's averages are updated when assignments or assignments associated with specific assessments are deleted.</p>

	Report Cards
1914	<p>Error occurs when generating report cards on the Generate Report Card screen if a student's first name is longer than 20 characters.</p> <p>The error that prevented running report cards on the Generate Report Card screen if a student's first name is longer than 20 characters has been corrected.</p>
	Attendance
S2081	<p>Period attendance records entered on Attendance by Student List are overwritten when period attendance is entered on Period Attendance screen.</p> <p>ProgressBook has been updated so that attendance records entered on the Attendance by Student List are not overwritten when period attendance is entered on the Period Attendance screen.</p>
1913	<p>Unable to delete students on the Delete Students screen if the students have saved period attendance by block records.</p> <p>The Delete Students screen has been updated so that students with saved period attendance by block records can be deleted.</p>
	ProSoft
S2092	<p>Unable to export batch attendance data.</p> <p>For districts that integrate with the ProSoft student information system, ProgressBook has been updated so that users can export batch attendance data.</p>
S2085	<p>Daily Attendance screen does not display when taking attendance for students assigned to a homeroom but not any classes.</p> <p>For districts that integrate with the ProSoft student information system, and enable the Enable Live SIS Integration feature, ProgressBook has been updated so that the Daily Attendance screen displays enabling the teacher to enter daily attendance.</p>

	Student Properties
F1986	<p>District of Service values imported from DASL are not displaying a valid value on the Student Properties screen.</p> <p>District of Service values imported from DASL now use the following rules to populate the District of Service list on the Student Properties screen:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If the value imported from DASL is "*****", the District of Service list displays the IRN for the student's home school district. • If the value imported from DASL is blank, the District of Service list displays a blank. • If a null value is imported from DASL, the District of Service list displays the IRN for the student's home school district. • If a value is imported from DASL that does not match the available list of values in the District of Service list in Special Services, the District of Service list displays the imported value.

Reference #	Issue Description
S2095	<p>The County of Residence list on the Student Properties screen becomes blank when a user saves the information on the IEP Cover Page. The list also displays “-” when the value is blank.</p> <p>The County of Residence list on the Student Properties screen now maintains the selected value when a user saves the IEP Cover Page. Additionally, the “-” no longer displays when the value in the County of Residence list is blank.</p>
S2098	<p>After the nightly integration process from the student information system, updated student demographic information is not updated to the Student Properties screen or the PDF form.</p> <p>The Student Properties screen and the student’s open PDF forms are now updated with the appropriate student demographic information after the nightly integration process has run.</p>
	Create from Existing
S2103	<p>Users receive an error when trying to create a Progress Report task from an existing IEP task where the name of the IEP Goal page causes the name of the Progress Report page to exceed 50 characters (since “Progress Report (IEP)” prefixes the name of each copied page of a Progress Report).</p> <p>The name of the copied Progress Report page is now truncated to 50 characters when a user creates a Progress Report task from an existing IEP task that contains long pages.</p>
S2104	<p>When a user creates a Progress Report task from an existing task, the created pages in the Progress Report task do not contain any information.</p> <p>When a user creates a new Progress Report task from an existing task, the created pages now contain the information from the original task.</p>
